Jodi and Russ' advice on getting funded in D&I:

- Where you are submitting for funding matters. If D&I knowledgeable reviewers, make sure to use D&I "language" and have a D&I person review for appropriateness of methods, frameworks and approaches, watch how much undefined jargon. May need a D&I co-investigator to be credible.
- Make sure the mechanism and proposed project "fit." If you are proposing development an intervention and the funders/reviewers expect this preliminary work to already be done, this is not a good fit.
- Make sure to illustrate the eventual use/dissemination of the study. Much more important in D&I to make sure this will get used in practice....and increasingly also can be 1) widely disseminated and b) sustained over time.
